

The functionality of GeQuo is comparable to PRS Fire's functionality, a web based solution. However, GeQuo is installed locally to manage the high confidentiality of data and entries.

Tailor-made pricing

GeQuo follows the structure of each current tariff recommendation from the German Insurance Association (GDV) for commercial property insurance. The application is based on MS ExcelTM.





- > Differentiated classification of various industry segments according to insurance sum classes and deductible classes

- > Consideration of all customary tariff features
- > Individual parameters for costs, trends and individual surcharges or discounts may be added easily

In GeQuo all addresses of Germany (about 20m) can be integrated. Thanks to an extremely high-performance solution ZÜRS-zones can be determined interactively and used for pricing.
